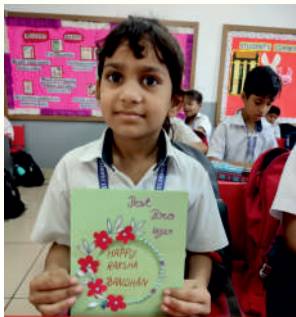

Festival of Bonding

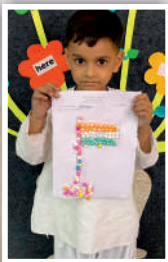
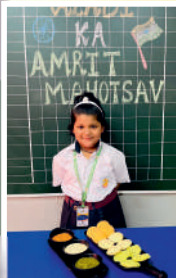
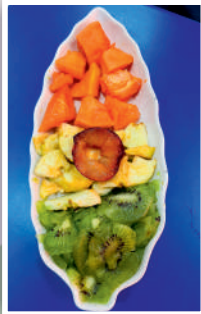
