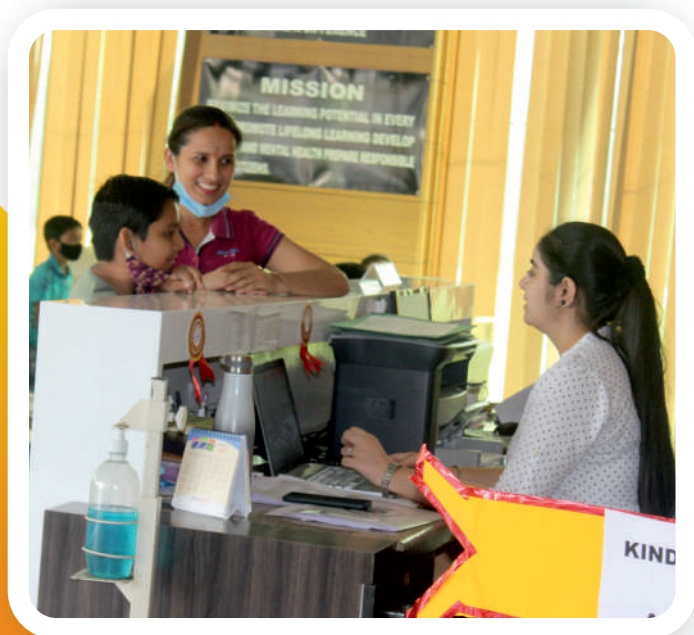
Parent Orientation Program

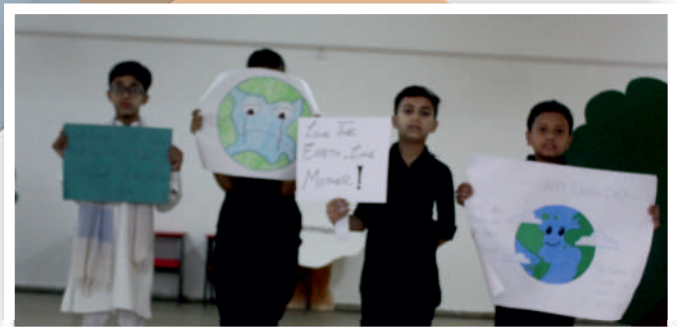
St Francis World School organized Cyber Security Workshop to make our students aware of the possible threats during internet usage and the ways to protect ourselves from them.
